Low grades are defined as:

AJA Yellow belt and under No orange tabs

BJC Yellow belt no tabs or up to 3 orange tabs for primary grades

BJA Yellow belt no tabs or up to 6th mon.

Senior Grades are Orange belt and under (also not having held Junior blue or higher).

Open grades are defined as:

Any grade any association - Please wear your highest grade.

LOW GRADES CAN ALSO ENTER THE OPEN GRADE EVENTS.

Half contest fee payable for those entering more than one event.

- **Junior contestants must be under the age of 16 on the 28-4-13 and must not have competed or graded at any Senior Judo Event.**
- THIS COMPETITION IS OPEN TO FULLY PAID UP MEMBERS OF ANY CLUB IN ANY ASSOCIATION.
- Contests will take place under A.J.A. rules. Armlocks and strangles are not allowed in any Junior low grade event and in the open grade event up to and including the under 45kg categories.
- Competitors who are affiliated to other associations as well as the A.J.A. must wear their highest grade.
- The use of inhalers will be strictly monitored throughout the event.
- The organisers will decide the method of elimination.
- The decision of the senior referee of the day will be final.
- The decision of the weighing in officer will be final.
- Coaching during the competition will not be allowed.
- All contestants enter at their own risk. The organisers accept no responsibility for any injuries sustained during the championship however caused.
- NO FOOD, DRINK OR SMOKING ALLOWED IN THE DOJO.
- Please do not leave litter.
- The organisers will decide any point not covered by these rules.
- The organisers are the EAST MIDLANDS AREA of the AMATEUR JUDO ASSOCIATION OF GREAT BRITAIN.
